Refusal of Unsafe Work

Employees have the right to refuse work they deem to be unsafe. If an employee has reasonable cause to believe any work puts themselves or others at risk, they must not perform the job or task. They must immediately notify your supervisor or employer, who will then take the appropriate steps to determine if the work is unsafe and to remedy the situation.
